

PUBLIC NOTICE

A vacancy on the Junction City Council, Place 1, with a remaining term of one year (ending in May 2009), will need to be filled. The vacancy will be filled during the City Council's regular meeting on June 9, 2008.

Persons interested in serving as an Alderman for the aforementioned term should notify the City Secretary of their reasons for so wanting to serve in writing by June 5th. In accordance with the standard eligibility requirements for a city office, a candidate must:

- (1) be a United States citizen;
- (2) be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election;
- (3) have not been determined mentally incompetent by a final judgment of a court;
- (4) have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities;
- (5) have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in the city for six months immediately preceding the deadline for filing an application for a place on the ballot;
- (6) must be a registered voter and reside in the city limits. Persons interested in serving must be at least 18 years of age and a resident of the City for at least two years (24 months).
