You have the right to request a Driving Safety Course if you have not completed one in the last one (1) year prior to this citation, and if you have a Valid Texas Driver's License. **You will lose this right if you do not contact the Judge beforehand for eligibility on or before your appearance date.** To request a driving safety course you must submit a request in writing by certified mail, enter a plea of guilty or no contest, provide proof of financial responsibility, and remit a fee of **\$106.10**.

If you furnish satisfactory proof within 10 working days of the violation that any of the following has been corrected (Operator's License, Registration, or Inspection), that charge may be dismissed upon receipt of proof and a \$20.00 Administrative Fee for each charge.

IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING THE FINE(S) OR OTHER VIOLATIONS NOT LISTED, YOU MAY CALL THIS OFFICE BETWEEN 2:00 - 5:00 PM. TUESDAY AND WEDNESDAY AFTERNOONS. WE DO NOT ACCEPT COLLECT CALLS OR PERSONAL CHECKS. FINES MUST BE PAID BY MONEY ORDER OR CASHIER'S CHECK. PLEASE RE-READ THIS LETTER BEFORE CALLING.

***Note: The Judge cannot discuss the merits of a pending judicial proceeding prior to trial (Canon 3(5) Code of Judicial Conduct). This means the Judge cannot discuss your citation with you before the trial.**

IMPORTANT MESSAGE

Annually, traffic law violations are recorded as a factor in about 85% of the rural traffic accidents in Texas. Approximately 60% of the traffic deaths in Texas occur on rural highways. The enforcement actions taken against you and any subsequent court actions are intended to secure compliance with the traffic laws by you and all other users of the highways. **Failure to comply with your written promise to appear in court as made on this citation will constitute a separate offense with which you may be charged and result in warrants being issued for your arrest. The issuance of arrest warrants will make you subject to entry into the wanted persons files of the Department.**

WARNING

If you fail to appear in court or if you fail to pay or satisfy a judgment ordering the payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the court, you may be denied renewal of your driver license.

Notice of Potential Suspension, Section 601.233, Transportation Code
“A second or subsequent conviction of an offense under the Texas Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act will result in the suspension of your driver’s license and motor vehicle registration unless you file and maintain evidence of financial responsibility with the Department of Public Safety for two years from the date of conviction. The Department may waive the requirement to file evidence of financial responsibility if you file satisfactory evidence with the Department showing that the time this citation was issued the vehicle was covered by a motor vehicle liability insurance policy or that you were otherwise exempt from the requirements to provide evidence of financial responsibility.”

DRIVING SAFETY COURSE

You may be able to require that this charge be dismissed by taking a driving safety course for a misdemeanor under Subtitle C, Title VII of the Transportation Code. A request to take a driving safety course can be made on or before the scheduled appearance date as shown on the face of the citation, and a plea of “no contest” or “guilty” Must be entered.

WARNING: “A conviction of an offense under a traffic law of this state or a political subdivision of this state may result in the assessment on your driver’s license of a surcharge under the Driver Responsibility Program.”
