Purpose of this Special Called Meeting:

The purpose of this meeting was to explore with Dr. Chandler various approaches and technologies that might be used to promote the City of Junction and Kimble County as an attractive location for small business entrepreneurs. It was a wide-ranging discussion that covered many aspects of "marketing Junction" for new economic development, including:

- Presenting Junction as the "New Frontier" of the Texas Hill Country, which has been experiencing robust economic growth and development in recent years.
- Highlighting the attractiveness of the more relaxed pace of a small-town environment, with ready access to many outdoor recreational opportunities.
- Identifying the needs and wants of increasing numbers of newcomers to Kimble County, including retirees and non-resident landowners with second homes or recreational properties here.

Other topics covered in the meeting were the range of services Dr. Chandler can offer to meet JTEDC needs, and where some of those needs might overlap with the needs of the Tourism board, which is also in discussions with Dr. Chandler.
